### Location and Accommodations:

There is Verizon coverage and internet access.

From OR-205 S/Fields Denio Rd, turn east on Whitehorse Ranch Lane and travel 3 miles, then turn left into the headquarters at the Trout Creek Ranch sign (above). Standard vehicles can be parked in front of/near the apartments, which is the first building you'll find on the left and attached to the warehouse. Larger vehicles can be parked nearby and we'll work with you on best locations.

### Distance & Fuel:

Trout Creek Ranch lies about 4 miles south of Fields, Oregon, which is 112 miles south of Burns, Oregon, and about 21 miles north of Denio, Nevada. Fuel is available at [Fields Station](#) in Fields, 112 miles north in [Burns](#), 85 miles north on 205 at [The Narrows](#), and at [Denio Junction](#), about 25 miles south of Fields on Fields-Denio road.

### Weather

It varies greatly in SE Oregon, especially at high elevations. Please bring clothing for a range of conditions from cold and wet to warm and sunny: Rain gear (pants & jacket), layers of warmth, hiking boots and socks, hats for sun, rain, and warmth, gloves or mittens, sunglasses, sunblock, mosquito repellent, binoculars, favorite field guides, and a day pack.

Oregon Desert Land Trust has many ongoing projects at Trout Creek Ranch and we hope you can take part in our conservation efforts. Please coordinate with us ahead of time for a volunteer event or to schedule a visit.

We have options to sleep indoors or outdoors and there are private indoor bathrooms with showers for both. Two indoor air-conditioned apartments have shared bedrooms and restrooms, stovetops, ovens, microwaves and fridges/freezers for meal preparation. There are also areas to camp on site or to park camping vehicles. They are close to separate indoor bathrooms/showers that are within a common space/meeting room.

Many facilities are being updated through volunteer work and generous donations. We continue to be amazed and appreciative of the ongoing generosity in this wonderful community.
